Guidelines for GENESIS EiR Cohort 2.0 Program

Gen-Next support for Innovative Startups (GENESIS) of Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY), Govt. of India provides Entrepreneur in Residence (EiR) grant support (up to Rs. 10 lakh) for the aspiring entrepreneurs.

Entrepreneur Eligibility

- 1. **Nationality:** The applicant must be an Indian citizen.
- 2. Age: The entrepreneur must be at least 18 years old at the time of application.
- 3. **Commitment:** The applicant must be a first-generation entrepreneur and committed to working full-time on the proposed startup idea during the EiR program duration.
- 4. **Applicant Type:** Applicant must be an individual innovator/ full-time UG/PG students with entrepreneurial pursuits/ founder of a DPIIT registered startup (≤ 2 years old at the time of application).

Startup/Innovator Eligibility

1. Stage of the Startup:

- Oncept Development, Validation / Problem-Solution Fit, Proof of Concept (PoC), or Prototyping/Working Prototype.
- O Must not have received significant external funding (exceeding ₹10 lakh, including government grants).
- The EiR must be physically incubated at our centre.
- The applicant shouldn't have been chosen or onboarded with any other Enabling Partner Under the GENESIS Scheme.

2. Sector Focus:

The proposed idea should focus on technology innovation aligned with the GENESIS scheme's objectives:

- Electronics & IT/ Deeptech (software or product)/ ICT space
- Emerging technologies (AI / ML, IoT, VLSI/Semiconductor, Cybersecurity, Blockchain, Quantum computing, AR/VR/Spatial and Immersive Tech)

3. Scalability and Impact:

• The startup must have the potential for scalability and create a measurable impact, especially in Tier 2 and Tier 3 cities.

4. Legal Compliance:

- If the startup is already incorporated, it must be registered as a Private Limited Company, LLP and registered partnership firm under applicable Indian laws.
- The entity must not be older than 2 year at the time of application.

5. **Originality:**

The startup/innovator idea must be original and not involve duplication of existing products/services or any form of plagiarism.

Regional Criteria

- 1. Location:
 - Priority will be given to startups and entrepreneurs from Tier 2 and Tier 3 cities to promote regional innovation.

Alignment with GENESIS Objectives

- 1. The proposed startup/idea should align with the overarching goals of the GENESIS scheme:
 - Promoting technology-led entrepreneurship.
 - Creating jobs and fostering regional innovation hubs.
 - Supporting sustainable and inclusive economic growth.
